

## Questions & Answers about the 2011 Government Tax Credit for Consumer Energy Efficiency:

**Q: Does Derden Inc. sell qualified HVAC equipment?**

**A: Yes!** We sell many different types of equipment that are eligible to receive the tax credit.

**Q: How do I find out which equipment qualifies?**

**Q: What is included in the Tax Credit?**

**A: Tax Credit: Beginning on January 1, 2011, there is a \$500 lifetime limit on the tax credit.** That means if you've gotten any energy efficiency tax credits from 2006 - 2010, then that counts towards your lifetime limit, and you can't go over \$500. For example, if you got \$800 (of then \$1,500 tax credit) in 2009, then you are not eligible for anything more in 2011. If you got a \$400 tax credit in 2006, then you can get an additional tax credit of up to \$100 in 2011. The \$500 tax credit can be on a single, or multiple products - but not more than \$500 total for your lifetime.

In 2011, tax credits are available, up to \$500 total, (for existing homes that are your "[principal residence](#)," NOT new construction,) for:
